Please announce

WELCOME TO ST. PAUL'S on this _____ Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Please stand.

Stay at the podium until it is time for you to read the readings. After the readings return to your seat, but, (IF THE DEACON IS NOT HERE) stay on the Altar until it is time to do the Prayer of the Faithful, then return to your seat. The DEACON CANDIDATE does not do the Prayer of the Faithful.

Thank you for helping in God's work; your part in the liturgy is important. It is necessary to read through your readings before Mass. *The Prayer of the Faithful is done by the Deacon. When he is not available, please be prepared to read them.*

You must resist the urge to rush through them. **Please pause several seconds between readings for careful reflection by all the listeners. Try to be as loud and clear as possible and speak directly into the microphone, adjust if necessary.** Pause after the first reading and do not announce the responsorial psalm; merely begin.

When the gifts are brought up and there are no altar servers, come to the altar to assist the priest with the collection basket(s).

EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS:

We offer Communion under both species and would, therefore, like to have **THREE** Eucharistic Ministers at each Mass. Please see the assignment sheet and if you are unable to be at mass, please make arrangements for someone to fill in for you. If the Deacon Candidate is not at Mass, please be prepared to administer the host.

Being close to the sacred species is an opportunity to grow in faith. Approach with faith and reverence and a sense of awe. God will give you grace as you minister to others. Please dress appropriately and help serve if no server is present. When the deacon is absent, two ministers are all that will be needed.

Do not rush. Wait until each activity is completed before coming to the lectern.
