November 21: OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE Solemnity

Readings: Dn 7:13-14/Rv 1:5-8/Jn 18:33b-37

"Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice." Do we really listen? Do we listen to the WORD when it is proclaimed at Mass? Do we read the WORD and allow Jesus to touch our hearts and convert us? Or are we distracted by the noise and the priorities of this world? In today's gospel, Jesus tells us that he is a King, but his Kingdom does not belong to this world. As his subjects, neither do we. We are on pilgrimage here and our homeland is heaven. As we journey together on this pilgrimage, let us remember that we serve Christ the King and heed his invitation to follow him more closely and pray the words he taught us "Thy will be done ..."

COVID Safety – Current Requirements

Parishioners who are **fully vaccinated** are not required to wear a face mask or social distance at Mass. **HOWEVER...**

- **Children under the age of 12 who are not vaccine eligible and those under the age of 16 who have not been vaccinated, may accompany and be seated with a vaccinated adult, but MUST wear a mask.** *This is being asked of us not only by the government, but more importantly, by our Bishop.*
- All who prefer to continue wearing facial covering and social distancing are free to do so.
- Those who are not fully vaccinated should observe social distancing of six feet from individuals not in their household. A face mask is required at Mass except when receiving Holy Communion.
- Even if vaccinated, we ask you to *respect* the 6-foot social distance from others who *are* wearing a mask.
