ST. VINCENT DE PAUL MONTHLY REPORT -- JUNE 2019

So often we, the members of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, must remind ourselves that true assistance is more than just handing out a box of food or giving money so a family will keep its apartment. Assistance is about healing. As Richard Rohr suggests in Immortal Diamond, Jesus did not just physically heal the leper or the mute or the blind, but He changed them, gave them a deeper healing and send them on their way back into community. Our interactions with those we meet are so small, but accompanied with the box of food, we can listen to a man’s sorrow, his struggle to feed his grandchildren because the parents are not doing well. We can assist, with rent, the young man who wants to stay away from drugs and encourage him to do so. We can speak to a young mother, newly separated from her husband, who needs food for her two young boys and tell her that she is not abandoned. How do we offer deeper healing?: We can be present to the Holy Spirit in each person, and be open to the deeper losses, to the deeper hungers, to the stories, to the hopes, to the fears. In addition, we can advocate for social change: push toward a more just distribution of wealth, increased social services and sustainable housing. And we can pray. Responding to our SSVP emergency phone line, throughout June, we assisted fourteen single adults and fifteen families with food; five single adults and two families with rent; two families with hydro; one family with gas. Our June Friendship dinner served 68 people. Thank you for your support and for your prayers as the members of SSVP strive to serve with tenderness and with love the people of God. Anne Stancek
