

The 10 Commandments for a Safe Return to St. Mary's

1. Prior to coming to Church	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Register for Mass by calling the office on Monday to Thursday between 1:00 PM and 4:00 PM - As seating will be done by family units, all members registered for Mass must arrive together in order to be seated. - Bring your own mask - Plan to arrive early (doors open 30 minutes prior to Mass) - Please note, at 10 minutes before Mass time, your assigned seats may be given away to others.
2. When arriving	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Please ensure to socially distance - Masks are to be worn by all people - over the age of 8. - You MUST enter the church by the West annex door (by the Mary Garden) - You will be greeted by a volunteer who will indicate when you can enter the Annex - When advised, enter the Annex
3. In the Annex	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You will be greeted by another volunteer - You will be informed of essential information - When advised, proceed up the stairs or by the elevator
4. At the entrance to the Worship Space	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You will be asked to sanitize your hands - You will be invited to enter the church when the way is clear
5. Inside the Worship Space	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - An usher will ask you a few questions and assign you a seat or seats. - You must remain in the seats assigned for you. - You will then be passed on to another usher who will escort you to your seat.
6. Being seated	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You will be escorted to your seat by way of the main aisle
7. After being seated	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Please remain in your assigned seat - Only use the washroom if absolutely necessary. - You will not be allowed to leave Mass early.
8. During Mass	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Remain in your pew. - During this reopening, please refrain from singing - Your mask is to be left on, removing it only to receive Holy Communion - Holy Communion is only to be received in the hand! - After receiving Holy Communion, you are to put your mask back on.
9. After the Closing Hymn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - After our communal "Hail Mary" you will be dismissed row by row, starting at the back - You are to use the Main Doors (unless you have need of the elevator) - You are asked to socially distance after leaving the church
10. After Mass	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Church is empty
