

RE: Renovations, Additions, and New Buildings

Axis and Ironshore Policy Period 2019-2020 include the ISO Building and Personal Property Coverage below.

1. Covered Property

(5) If not covered by other insurance:

- (a) Additions under construction, alterations, and repairs to the building or structure;
- (b) Materials, equipment, supplies and temporary structures, on or within 100 feet of the described premises, used for making additions alterations or repairs to the building or structure.

(3) Period of Coverage

With respect to insurance provided under this Coverage Extension for Newly Acquired Or Constructed Property, coverage will end when any of the following first occurs:

- (c) This policy expires;
- (d) 30 days expire after you acquire the property or begin construction of that part of the building that would qualify as covered property; or
- (e) You report the values to us. We will charge you an additional premium for values reported from the date you acquire the property or begin construction of that part of the building that would qualify as covered property.

This endorsement extends/includes coverage for Builders Risk (property under construction), however, you must notify DPC and Waldorf prior to - or within 30 days of start date - with details of the property renovation/addition/Construction project. In addition, send the Construction Form for any construction projects.

NOTE: This coverage does not replace the coverage that the Contractor (CG) must provide to you. Please be sure to secure a Certificate of Liability insurance naming the Parish/Diocese as Certificate Holder and Additional Insured with respect to the construction project. Under the Description of Operations, please reference: Project Description; Approximate start date / completion date; Contract Cost / Estimated Construction Cost.

The Course of Construction Form for Renovations, Additions, and New Builds is used in conjunction with the Diocese of Amarillo Property Update Form.

This form gives the Diocese and Waldorf a heads up of your upcoming projects. Complete the form before a project begins by the Priest, page 1 and General Contractor/Contractor, page 2.

Please do not get the two confused.

1. Course of Construction Form is before a project.
2. Update Form is after a project. Send upon completion of the project to add to the property schedule.

Send the Course of Construction Form and the contractor's Certificate of Liability to the DPC Risk Management and Waldorf Risk Solutions. Reiterate priest sends the form before the project begins.
