

REMIND Text Messaging / E-mail Tool

What is REMIND?

REMIND is a safe text messaging and e-mail communication tool used by many schools, CCD programs, and youth groups all over the country.

How does REMIND work?

The leader sends a text message to the REMIND organization, and the organization forwards the text message to everyone who signed up to be part of the group. It will be received as a text or an e-mail, depending on how the individual signed up.

Does the leader have the participants' cell phone numbers or email addresses, and vice versa?

No. All communications are sent as a blind copy.

What will the youth group use REMIND for?

Only to send out important communications, such as letting people know we are cancelling an event due to snow, or reminding people about upcoming deadlines to sign up for events.

Will the youth group send a text message or e-mail to a teen individually?

No. The youth group will only send out group texts / e-mails.

Is REMIND safe?

Yes. The REMIND organization keeps a record of all text messages and e-mails that are sent.

Who should sign up for REMIND?

Parents and teens who belong to the youth group.
