Bringing Jesus to Our Work and Prayer

Jesus enjoyed resting in the home of his friends Lazarus, Martha, and Mary because of their affection and hospitality. Martha was a big part of this hospitality because she was energetic and dedicated to making sure Jesus was cared for. Mary made him feel at home differently, as she was hungry for the Lord's teaching. She was open, interested, and attentive.

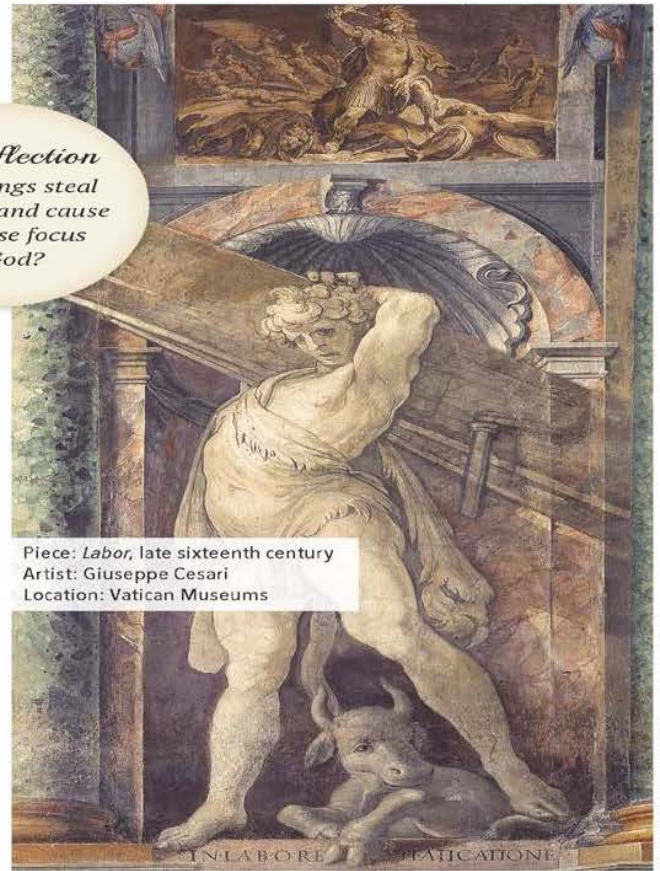
Yet on this occasion Martha is overcome with the urgent and leaves aside the important. Martha receives Christ in her home while Mary brings him into her heart. Living in relationship with Jesus always includes these two elements. Part of our love for him involves sitting at his feet in prayer. This is no doubt the "better part." Yet, serving Jesus also requires an active, busy life of work and responsibilities. Far from being an obstacle, work should be an occasion for a closer relationship with Jesus.

The key is having a unifying center to life; that center should be Jesus. He is the "why" we do what we do—whether work, play, or pray. Martha wasn't mistaken in serving Jesus' needs, but she lost focus with anxiety and worries. How to maintain this focus? First, pray regularly to remain centered. Second, don't worry about the small things at work or home. Third, frequently redirect your intention with a short, motivating motto like, "All for you, my Jesus" or "Your kingdom come!" Find one that works for you.

Let's not lose sight of the Lord of our work when doing the work of the Lord.

Sin embargo, en esta ocasión Martha se vence con lo urgente y deja de lado lo importante. Marta recibe a Cristo en su hogar mientras María lo lleva a su corazón. Vivir en relación con Jesús siempre incluye estos dos elementos. Parte de nuestro amor por él implica sentarnos a sus pies en oración. Esto es sin duda la "mejor parte". Sin embargo, servir a Jesús también requiere una vida activa y ocupada de trabajo y responsabilidades. Lejos de ser un obstáculo, el trabajo debe ser una ocasión para una relación más cercana con Jesús. La clave es tener un centro unificador para la vida; Ese centro debe ser Jesús. Él es el "por qué" que hacemos lo que hacemos, ya sea trabajar, jugar u orar. Martha no se equivocó al atender las necesidades de Jesús, pero perdió el enfoque con ansiedad y preocupaciones. ¿Cómo mantener este enfoque? Primero, ora regularmente para permanecer centrado. Segundo, no te preocupes por las cosas pequeñas en el trabajo o en el hogar. Tercero, frecuentemente redirija su intención con un breve y motivador lema como, "¡Todos por usted, mi Jesús" o "¡Venga su reino!" Encuentre uno que funcione para usted. No perdamos de vista al Señor de nuestra obra cuando hacemos la obra del Señor.

SAINT PROFILE OF THE MONTH**



ST. MARY MAGDALENE

Feast Day: July 22
Canonized: Pre-Congregation

St. Mary Magdalene is a legendary example of God's mercy and grace. The precise dates of her birth and death are unknown, but we do know she was present with Christ during his public ministry, death and resurrection. She is mentioned at least a dozen times in the Gospels.

The Gospels agree that Mary was originally a great sinner. Jesus cast seven demons out of her when he met her. After this, she told several women she associated with and these women also became followers.

There is also debate over if Mary Magdalene is the same unnamed women, a sinner, who weeps and washes Jesus' feet with her hair in the Gospel of John. Scholars are skeptical this is the same person. Despite the scholarly dispute over her background, what she did in her subsequent life, after meeting Jesus, is much more significant. She was certainly a sinner whom Jesus saved, giving us an example of how no person is beyond the saving grace of God.

During Jesus' ministry, it is believed that Mary Magdalene followed him, part of a semi-permanent entourage who served Jesus and his Disciples. Mary likely watched the crucifixion from a distance along with the other women who followed Christ during His ministry. Mary was present when Christ rose from the dead, visiting his tomb to anoint his body only to find the stone rolled away and Christ, very much alive, sitting at the place they laid Him. She was the first witness to His resurrection.

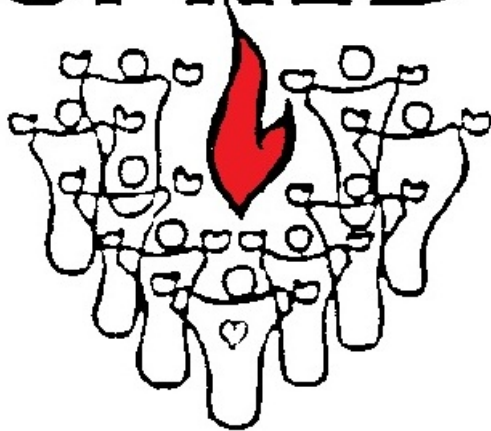
