

Try It! You'll Like It!

If only temptation was obvious, we might have a better chance of avoiding it. But sometimes it's so subtle. It often disguises itself as something rather attractive. This is precisely what happened in the Garden of Eden. Scripture says temptation takes on a living form—a serpent that convinces the woman that the fruit of the wisdom tree will make them “like gods, who know good and evil” (Genesis 3:5).

Who wouldn't jump at such a possibility? Actually, who hasn't already fallen into that trap—acting as if we are God, thinking we know everything or wishing to be in complete control? Our faith certainly encourages us to become more and more like God. What made that desire wrong was the way Adam and Eve sought to become like gods in their own way, not God's way.

The Gospel passage tells us that Jesus also was tempted. Who doubts that Jesus wanted to be successful in his ministry? But what would he do to ensure success? Would he use divine power to attract a following? No! Would he call upon God to protect him from misunderstanding, rejection, even physical harm? No! Would he bargain with the devil, who obviously exercised power over many people? No! That was not the way he would be the Messiah. Unlike the couple in the Garden, Jesus recognized what was wrong even when it was disguised as something good. How good are we at recognizing temptation in our lives?

Si solo la tentación fuera obvia, podríamos tener una mejor oportunidad de evitarla. Pero a veces es tan sutil. A menudo se disfraza de algo bastante atractivo. Esto es precisamente lo que sucedió en el Jardín del Edén. Las Escrituras dicen que la tentación adquiere una forma viva: una serpiente que convence a la mujer de que el fruto del árbol de la sabiduría los hará "como dioses, que conocen el bien y el mal" (Génesis 3: 5). ¿Quién no saltaría ante tal posibilidad? En realidad, ¿quién no ha caído en esa trampa, actuando como si fuéramos Dios, creyendo que lo sabemos todo o deseando tener el control total? Nuestra fe ciertamente nos anima a ser más y más como Dios. Lo que hizo que ese deseo fuera incorrecto fue la forma en que Adán y Eva trataron de convertirse en dioses a su manera, no a la manera de Dios. El pasaje del Evangelio nos dice que Jesús también fue tentado. ¿Quién duda de que Jesús quisiera tener éxito en su ministerio? Pero, ¿qué haría él para garantizar el éxito? ¿Usaría el poder divino para atraer seguidores? ¡No! ¿Llamaría a Dios para protegerlo de malentendidos, rechazos e incluso daños físicos? ¡No! ¿Negociaría con el diablo, quien obviamente ejercía poder sobre muchas personas? ¡No! Esa no era la forma en que él sería el Mesías. A diferencia de la pareja en el jardín, Jesús reconoció lo que estaba mal, incluso cuando se disfraza de algo bueno. ¿Qué tan buenos somos para reconocer la tentación en nuestras vidas?

A MESSAGE FOR LENT

We just celebrated Ash Wednesday and are now on our Lenten Journey. And what a journey this will be for us. We understand and know the three of pillars of Lent, which are Prayer, Fasting and Alms giving. We all pray a little more, to reconcile ourselves with God, and lead us into closer relationship with him. We always fast and give something up, hoping it will help us lose some weight and feel better about ourselves. The third pillar is Alms giving. We give of ourselves to help those less fortunate than us through our weekly donations and through programs like the Catholic Relief Service Rice Bowl project.

The original meaning of the word Lent, is "Spring". The season of spring represents for us a new beginning, new life. Spring is not just a season, but an action as well. Maybe it's time for us to spring forward in our relationship with Christ. Maybe it is time for us to spring forward and heal those hurts that have been holding us back from being in relationship with our family and friends. This is one of the most powerful passages in scripture and what I try to live by daily. There are so many opportunities at All Saints to be Christ like to others. We have many ministries that reach out to those in need that could always use some help. Our Tuesday Morning Breakfast group, our Shower Ministry and our St. Vincent De Paul Society all reach out to the homeless, poor and needy of our parish. Our Condolence Ministry helps and supports families that have just lost a loved one, and sometimes don't necessarily know which way to turn. Our ministry to the sick brings the Body of Christ to those people in hospitals or homebound, that aren't able to make it to church, but still want to receive and feel the presence of Christ within.

We also support the Catholic Relief Service Rice Bowl project. Through your donations we are able to make a difference in the lives of people in 3rd world countries around the globe. No donation is too small. As Jesus fed the multitudes of people with a few loaves and fish, we can change the world when we come together as Christ calls us to.

Be blessed this Lent. Reflect on who Christ calls each of us to be. Always remember his sacrifice for us and how we are called to carry on his mission throughout the world.

ALL SAINTS YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY



I've learned there isn't a one-size-fits-all friend; that the definition of a "true friend" is unique to the individual; someone I find not to be so true is a perfectly true one to someone else. I've learned that certain friendships I chased, the ones I felt inclined to put more effort into for various reasons I once was too ashamed to admit - the ones, in retrospect that were one-sided - were the ones that left me feeling the most disappointed and heartbroken, but it is these times that made me realize the real friends I did have and made me appreciate them more. I've learned that sometimes, we hang onto friends we know we should let go of, and the friends we should hang onto, we let go of because it's easier than being vulnerable. With some friends, I didn't realize I expected more than who they were and had to let go, thinking they didn't care enough, and some did the same with me.

Later I learned that we cannot expect us and others to be more than who we are, and that an indicator of a true friendship is that we don't feel like we have to be anybody else but...us. I've forced myself to fit into certain groups, later realizing that it was ok I didn't fit in - it didn't make me any less and neither side was bad, it just didn't...fit (you can't put a circle-shaped peg in a square-shaped hole, right?). For me, my lifelong friends seem to be the ones that I don't necessarily talk to or see everyday, but I know beyond a shadow of a doubt that I mean a lot to them because they've gone out of their way to make that clear, to make me feel appreciated and loved (and I hope they feel I do the same), and what keeps us strong is sharing similar, if not the same, underlying values. And there are friends who I've just met but feel like I've known my whole life; for some, I seem to be too much, and others, I seem to not do enough - and that's ok because I'm not for everyone and everyone's not for me - and I've learned that the friends that fit me are the ones who feel I am just right, and vice versa. Most importantly, I've learned that if I am not at peace with myself, I am not at peace with others, and we are not at peace with ourselves without a relationship with God, and so it's important to continue nurturing this relationship as well as my efforts in practicing self-love and care. Only when we fully grasp just how much God loves us can we truly love and accept ourselves, and thus strengthen our ability to love others.
