### From the Pastor's Desk

My good friend and mentor, Fr. Patrick Hennessy, used to like to pray at Mass: “Deliver us O Lord from useless worry.” I remember then thinking to myself that he was not supposed to change the words of the liturgy. I was his seminarian in residence in Christ the King Parish in the South Bronx for two summers in 1989 and 1990. He would enjoy it when I would quote the “proper” way to do things and say things. When I say “he enjoyed” when I tried to correct him, I really mean that he kind of laughed at me in my all knowing wisdom as a seminarian while he was a priest for over thirty years. I think now as I make it through my twenty sixth year as a priest, I must admit that he was right in this prayer. “Deliver us O Lord from useless worry.” Because he said this prayer every day, it was no surprise then to notice how happy, energetic and positive he was in practically every situation. Even when he was diagnosed with the cancer that would eventually kill him, he wrote to his friends and shared with us the consolation the Word of God gave him daily, especially in the book of Jeremiah where the Lord comforts Jeremiah by saying, “I have a plan for you.”

I must admit that at times, it is easy to become anxious. We could quickly make a list of the things and circumstances that provoke one to become afraid, nervous, worrisome and anxious. Indeed, here is my short list lately: The impact of the scandals of the church which seem to be unending; the heated dialogue concerning Pope Francis and his leadership; the violence in the world; the vicious divisiveness in our politics; the parish and school expenses; the repairs, the bills, the maintenance issues, etc. Then there is the deeply personal list that come in the form of questions: “Am I missing too many opportunities to pray?” “Am I neglecting certain needs in the parish that are calling out for attention?” “Are we losing so many young people to the Catholic faith?” The list goes on....

These are just some rambling thoughts. Some have said to me, “Thomas, it’s because you are Irish that you easily worry!” I don’t think the Irish corner the market on “useless worry,” although they probably might lead the way in some cases! How grateful I become, however, when I think of my dear friend, Fr. Hennessy, and many other wonderful people who have taught me and showed me how not to be afraid of anything when one is trying to do the will of God.

## IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

I enjoyed this little quotation from Fr. Joseph M. Esper's book, *Saintly Solutions to Life's Common Problems*. Fr. Esper especially notes in his book how the Saints regularly faced anxiety. Here are his words:

*St. Paul of the Cross advises us, "When you notice that our heart is moving away even the tiniest bit from that inner peace that comes from the living faith-experience of the divine presence in the soul, stop and examine what the cause of this anxiety might be. Maybe it is some worry concerning your house or children, or some situation you cannot change at present. Bury it in God's loving will." Remind yourself that nothing can happen without the Lord's knowledge and permission — and as a loving Father, He will never abandon or forget you.*

May we all live that prayer that Fr. Hennessy prayed every day: "Deliver us O Lord from useless worry." It's a great prayer!

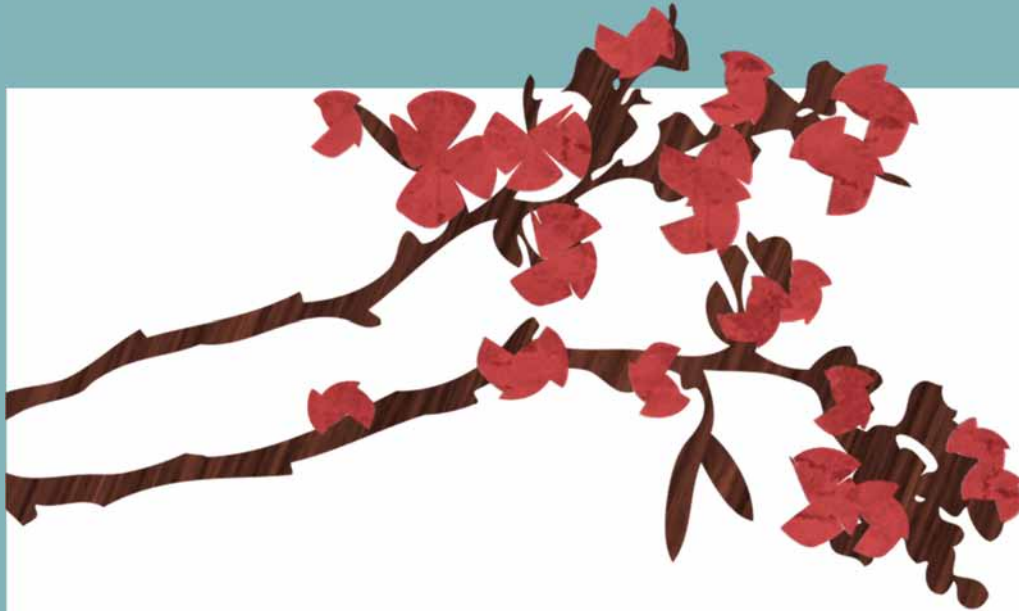

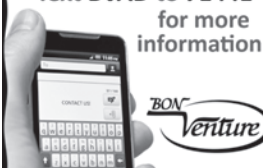

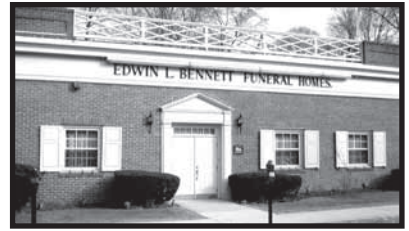
