I. Course Description

This course offers a complete overview of the Social Doctrine of Catholic Church teaching. It describes the principles and major themes of the social doctrine and seeks to analyze the main challenges Catholics face in the present age.

II. Course Outcome

This course proposes a general study of the social teaching of the Church, emphasizing the importance of living and facing the different challenges that life presents us under the following moral values: truth, freedom, justice, mercy and love.

III. Course Outline and Goals

Students will learn the basic principles of the Catholic Social Doctrine: human dignity, the common good, subsidiarity and solidarity.
