MASS INTENTIONS GUIDELINES

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Initial mass requests will be in writing on the supplied form and limited to 5 per family per half-year, no more than 2 of which may be Sunday masses. 2. Mass request forms may be dropped off in-person from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM on Tuesday, November 2. Requests mailed in or dropped off earlier will be processed after the in-person drop-off. 3. Requests from the initial drop-off will be processed in the order received. If a mass you select is already taken, the next available mass will be assigned for you. You will be informed of the masses you have received and may request changes at that point. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. The book will open for general requests starting on Tuesday, November 9, 2021. Only masses for January through June 2022 will be available. July to December requests will be taken at a later date. 5. If you are requesting a mass for a first anniversary of a death, a 25th or a 50th wedding anniversary, that request may be submitted for any date in 2022. 6. The masses for Holy Thursday, Easter Vigil, the Feast of St. Ignatius and All Souls Day, are reserved for novena masses or special intentions for the parish as a whole. 7. The Church rule is that masses be for a single intention. For pastoral reasons, we do allow the inclusion of 2 first names with the same last name (e.g., parents) or two family names (e.g. Smith and Jones Families). 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 8. Intentions may be edited for length and appropriate content. Longer intentions may appear one way in the bulletin but in a shortened form in the universal prayer at mass. 9. We will make every attempt to announce the mass during the universal prayer. 10. Please remember, though, that if the intention is published in the bulletin and the mass is said with that intention in mind, the Church's obligation is met.
