

## Classroom Supply List: Mrs. Murphy's Kindergarten

It is time to start shopping for those back to school supplies! Here is a list of classroom supplies needed for each student, and also a list of suggested classroom donations for use during the school year. As the year progresses, I will send home individual notes when a student becomes short on supplies, or when the class is in need of something.

Your child will need the following supplies for the school year:

- Back pack
- Bath towel/small blanket/beach towel: this will be used for eating lunch outside and for any other school work that we might do outside this year.
- Pencil box
- Pencils (yellow #2)- several sharpened is best\*
- Eraser(s)\*
- Crayons (you can also purchase a plastic soap dish/tiny crayon box to put the crayons in if you would like the crayons to last a little longer)\*
- Pack of markers (broad or fine tip, it does not matter)\*
- Dry erase marker(s)\*
- Glue sticks (we go through these rather quickly so it is good to have several)\*
- Scissors
- Sketch pad for drawing and coloring
- Two-pocket folder (this will be designated the 'take home folder' and will be used EVERYDAY!)
- Wide-ruled notebook for journaling (in the past, Walmart has carried one with both lines and a space above for both writing and drawing)
- Old shirt to wear while painting
- Water bottle (water fountains will be off limits this year)

### Classroom donations (optional):

- Box(es) of Kleenex
- Disinfecting wipes
- Paper towels
- Hand sanitizer
- Scratch paper
- Extra glue sticks/crayons/pencils

\*it is usually best if you buy several of these items while they are on sale to have at home in case your child runs out during the school year.
