Religious Education News ... NEW! Children's Mass... Fr. Benedict will be holding a special Mass for Children on Sun, Nov 3rd at 10:30am in the Main Hall. Our regular 10:30am Mass will be taking place concurrently in the Church. Parents are encouraged to attend the regular mass & their children attend the Children's Mass. The Children's Mass will be specifically designed so children can better understand what is taking place and participate in the Mass at their level. All catechism students are encouraged to attend, and class will take place immediately following the Children's Mass.

Grade 6 Class Mass... The grade 6 students are asked to attend the 10:30am Mass on Sunday Oct 20th as a class. The class will be sitting together in the reserved seating area at the front of the church with their teacher.
