Religious Education News... With the announcement that all schools are cancelled until at least May 11th, it is now clear that the remainder of the material left to cover in our catechism classes must be completed in another manner as we will not be able to gather together physically before catechism classes were scheduled to finish on May 3rd.

In cooperation with RCL Benzinger, we are pleased to offer you online access to all the Be My Disciples Content for grades 1-7 via their Flourish Online Catechism site. This access includes your child's textbook in ebook form (in case it has been misplaced or left at the Parish), as well as games, prayer cards, virtual church tours, chapter review quizzes and much more.

It is our hope that, through this resource, your child can access all the content that they would have received in class time, therefore eliminating the need for make-up classes once COVID-19 restrictions are lifted.
