St. Paul's Notice- Re-opening Daily Masses... With Phase 3 of Renew PEI underway, we have re-opened the Church for Daily Masses (Monday-Saturday). Public Health protocols allow gatherings of 15 people only inside during this phase, so we have to restrict each Mass to a maximum of 15 people. Therefore, **TO ATTEND A MASS, YOU MUST PRE-REGISTER.** Registration is available for all Masses in June. Please contact the office to register either in person (10:00am-4:00pm), by phone 902-436-5112 or email office@stpaulsparish.ca. There will be two Masses per day (Monday-Saturday) at 9:00am and 6:30pm. Please indicate your preference as to which Mass you would like to register for, as well as, the number of people in your party. You will need to check in upon arrival so please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to the start of Mass, as no one will be admitted once Mass has started. **Only people who are registered will be admitted to any given Mass.** Thank you for your patience and support as we begin the re-opening process.
