St. Paul's Daily Masses... With Phase 3 of Renew PEI underway, we have re-opened the Church for Daily Masses (Monday-Saturday). At this time, Public Health protocols allow inside gatherings of up to 15 people, so we have to have attendance restrictions for every Mass. You will need to check in upon arrival so please arrive at least 10 minutes early for Mass, as no one will be admitted once Mass begins. **Only people who are registered will be admitted to any given Mass.** Thank you for your patience and support as we begin the re-opening process.

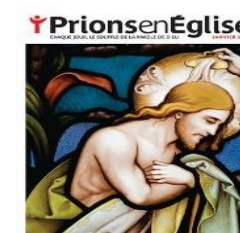
