**Catechism 2020-2021:** It's time to register your children for Sunday School! Due to Covid-19, we need to know exactly how many children we will be teaching this year in order to make plans to keep them physically distanced. Dates and Times of classes will be announced only after we have determined the size of each class. **Confirmation 2020 Update...** Dates have been set for our confirmation class of 2020. Due to COVID-19 regulations, we will be having 2 ceremonies, one on Tues Sept 15<sup>th</sup> @ 7pm, and a second on Thurs Sept 17<sup>th</sup> @ 7pm. **We ask that only the Candidates, Sponsors and the Candidates Parents attend the ceremonies in order to keep the number of those gathered under 100.** There will be a rehearsal and opportunity for confessions on Monday Sept 14<sup>th</sup> for all candidates and sponsors at 6pm.
