SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Please notify the parish office of the seriously ill or aged who are confined to their homes so that they might receive the Anointing of the Sick.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY EUCHARIST: We gladly bring this sacrament to the sick or shut-ins. Please notify us.

Six Ways I Can Make My Parish Better

2. **Be welcoming.** When you come together on the weekend for Mass, think of it as a large family reunion — with people you know well, know slightly, and don't know at all.

Introduce yourself to people you don't know, especially if they are sitting alone in church or standing by themselves at the coffee-and-donut hour. If they're new to the parish, offer to give them a tour, introduce them to other parishioners, or simply tell them why you love the parish. Enthusiasm is catching!

Watch your nonverbal communication too. If you're sitting on the end of a pew, for example, don't make others crawl over you to get to middle seats.

Remember to smile; take the time to compliment the people sitting around you on everything from their singing ability to the cuteness of their kids.

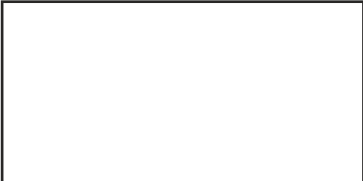
