## **DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION**

The following is the new procedure for reception of Holy Communion:

- At the start of the distribution of Holy Communion move forward in single file maintaining 6 feet between each person. There are markers on the floor for where to stand.
- Sanitize hands from the table or automatic sanitizer dispenser.
- Remove your mask as you approach the priest.
- Receive the Host in your hand ONLY.
- Consume the Host in front of the priest. Don’t walk away with the Host.
- Replace the mask over your mouth and nose and return to your seat.
