EDUCATIONAL CORNER

**How to Forgive the Church
Why Should I Forgive?**

When you forgive, it doesn't affect the Church as much as it affects you. Forgiveness frees you from anger, resentment, frustration, and pain. It allows you to let the poison drain out of the wounds, so it can begin to heal.

Experts agree that forgiveness is good for you. Without forgiveness, bitterness takes control. It hardens your heart. It affects your prayer life, your relationships, your thought processes, and even your health.

In the Gospels, Jesus tells us to forgive. When Peter asked if it is enough to forgive seven times, Jesus tells him to forgive seventy times seven times (Mt. 18:22).

Jesus assured us that if we forgive, we will be forgiven our failings (Mt. 6:14). And, on the cross, Jesus gave us an example of forgiveness when he prayed, "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do" (Lk. 23:34).
