MISSION

BAPTISM: Please call the parish office to make arrangements. Baptism is administered after Mass on Sundays. Those desiring other times may make special arrangements. Attendance at Baptismal Instructions is required before the Sacrament is administered.

MARRIAGE: Arrangements should be made at least 6 months in advance. Attendance at Pre-Cana Conferences is required.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION: Both Parishes - 30 minutes before daily Mass.

Saturday - Holy Spirit - North Collins; Before and After 5:30 p.m. Mass. Others by Appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Please notify the parish office of the seriously ill or aged who are confined to their homes so that they might receive the Anointing of the Sick.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY EUCHARIST: We gladly bring this sacrament to the sick or shut-ins. Please notify us.

NEW OR MOVING PARISHIONERS: Please register as soon as possible by calling during weekday office hours for an appointment. If moving, please notify the parish office.

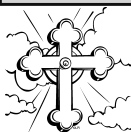

EDUCATIONAL CORNER

How to Make a Good Confession

Contrition: This involves regret for the sins committed and the resolution not to do them again. The penitent will need to prayerfully examine his or her conscience. Our motives for sorrow should arise from our faith in Christ. The following Act of Contrition expresses in prayer what "contrition" means:

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart.
In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good,
I have sinned against you whom I should love
above all things.

I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance,
to sin no more, and to avoid
whatever leads me to sin.

Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us.
In his name, my God, have mercy. Amen

Confession: Confessing our sins opens us to reconciliation. We look directly at our sins and take responsibility for them. Confession of sins to a priest is an essential act of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. After a diligent examination of consciences, we must confess all our sins.

Satisfaction: Most of our sins injure others. We need to repair the harm. For example, this could mean restoring the reputation of someone we have undermined, apologizing, repairing a friendship, or paying compensation for injuries or damaged or stolen goods. Our sins also have a negative effect on our own souls. The penance we receive from the priest is meant to be an effective step in our self improvement.
