**BAPTISM:** Please call the parish office to make arrangements. Baptism is administered after Mass on Sundays. Those desiring other times may make special arrangements. Attendance at Baptismal Instructions is required before the Sacrament is administered.

**MARRIAGE:** Arrangements should be made at least 6 months in advance. Attendance at Pre-Cana Conferences is required.

**SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:** Both Parishes - 30 minutes before daily Mass.  
Saturday - Immaculate Conception - Eden; 3:30 p.m.

Saturday - Holy Spirit - North Collins; Before and After 5:30 p.m. Mass. Others by Appointment.

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:** Please notify the parish office of the seriously ill or aged who are confined to their homes so that they might receive the Anointing of the Sick.

**SACRAMENT OF HOLY EUCHARIST:** We gladly bring this sacrament to the sick or shut-ins. Please notify us.

**NEW OR MOVING PARISHIONERS:** Please register as soon as possible by calling during weekday office hours for an appointment. If moving, please notify the parish office.
