CAR VOLUNTEERS, here's what to do:

- 🎃 Arrive at the St. Paul Church parking lot as close to **5:15 pm as possible**. You will need time to set up your decorations once you are parked.
- 🎃 Provide some treats for the children. You will also be given an additional supply of treats from those that are donated by others. We will let you know the final count.
- 🎃 Decorate your trunk any way you'd like-- **be creative!** For ideas, go online and search "trunk or treat" images. Please not too scary for the little ones. You can dress up too!
- 🎃 If you want to illuminate your trunk, please remember **NO candles/flames of any kind!**
- 🎃 **No glass decorations of any kind!**
- 🎃 Your car must remain parked until the end of the event. (The event runs from 6:00-7:00).
- 🎃 If you wish to be next to someone, arrive at the same time. We cannot "save spaces".
- 🎃 If the case of inclement weather, the event will be canceled.

ATTENDEES, here's what to do:

- 👤 All children are welcome with their families.
- 👤 Arrive between 5:30pm and 6:00pm and park in the new lot or on Alling Street.
- 👤 Dress in appropriate Halloween costumes - keep in mind this is a kid-friendly event!
- 👤 Please bring a bag for your treats (Note: There will be allergy-safe treats!)
- 👤 ***Admission is a canned good & a donation of a bag of individually wrapped candy (1 per child)***

You'll need to register as one of the following:

- * **CAR VOLUNTEER - COME WITH A DECORATED CAR** (No Trunk O' Treaters)
- * **CAR VOLUNTEER with ATTENDEES** (Indicate how many children)
- * **ATTENDEES ONLY** (No Car. Please indicate how many children)
