August 8th – Ice Cream Social

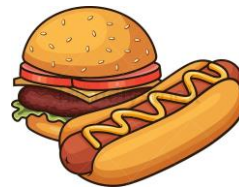
August 22nd – Adoration

Who's your Saint?! This meeting will work much like an online quiz and in the end, you will discover your saint soulmate. Bring your phones.



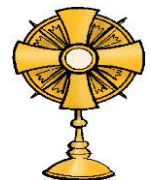
Cookout: This meeting is all about enjoying the wonderful community we all share in. Lots of food, lots of games, lots of fun!!!
