It is understandable that children of a certain age are curious and may search the internet for answers to questions that they may have instead of addressing a parent or guardian. Please speak to your children about this and impress upon them the seriousness of this matter.

The internet is a wonderful tool if it is used correctly. Try to be aware of what your child is doing on the internet. Each day we hear terrible stories of children who have met predators on the internet. We need to keep our children safe.

If students were found to be on inappropriate websites while in school, disciplinary measures would be taken. I thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
