Welcome to Kindergarten! We are so excited to meet your children in the fall! We often get questions about how to prepare children for Kindergarten. The best thing that you can do is read!

This summer we are asking that all students entering Kindergarten read regularly. This can be anything: picture books, chapter books, magazines, cookbooks, comic books, video game manuals... anything! It is best if parents read to pre-readers, however, any time your child spends looking at a book is considered reading.

The idea is to keep things fun, however, there are some things that you can do with your child as you read:

- Identify familiar letters and words
- Make predictions (What do you think will happen next?)
- Discuss the pictures
- Identify the characters
- Discuss what happens at the beginning, middle, and end of the story
- Discuss the problem and solution in the story

Every time your child reads, have him or her color one of the pictures on the attached pages. The pages are labeled July and August, however, as long as you are reading at any point in the summer we are happy!

We can't wait to meet you next school year!

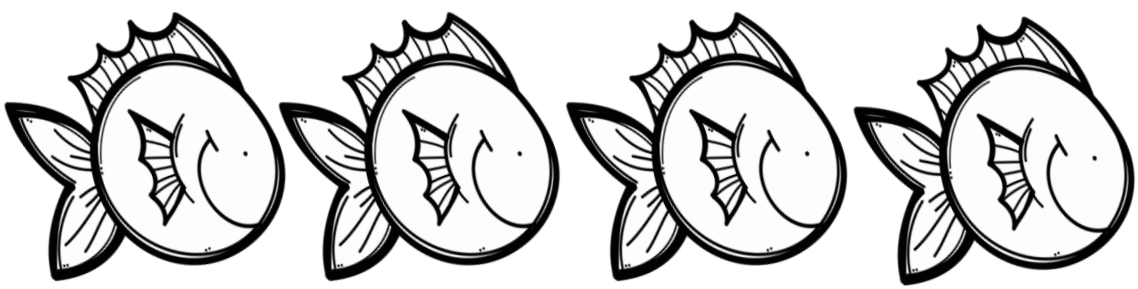
