

## Grade 1 Summer Reading

Parents,

Summer work is assigned for the time frame of July 6<sup>th</sup> to August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020. During this time, it is expected that your child complete 1 hour of work in each subject - ELA and Math at Edgenuity ([thelearningodyssey.com](http://thelearningodyssey.com)). Each activity will take about 20 minutes to complete.

In addition to the above your child has been assigned 6 books to read.

Fictional texts:

1. The Cow that went Oink! By Bernard Most
2. The Blind Men and the Elephant by Karen Backstein and Annie Mitra
3. Peter's Chair by Ezra Jack Keats

Non-Fiction texts:

1. What's Under the Ocean? By Melvin and Gilda Berger
2. Scientists Ask Questions by Ginger Garrett
3. A Day with Firefighters by Jodie Shepherd

Your child should complete "Balloon Retelling" for each fictional text. "Blast off with Non-Fiction" should be completed for each non-fiction text. If your child is not reading independently, please assist your child by reading to him or her.

Summer reading consists of 6 required texts. However, I would encourage your child to challenge himself/herself to read 1 book per week. The above books can be written on the summer reading log and count as part of the reading challenge.

Reading is an important skill that continues to improve with consistent practice. Use the attached reading log to chart your child's reading progress.
