



Important Dates to Remember

- **May 31, 2021 - \$800 School Fee is due**
- **June 2021 – Math and Spanish Placement Exams will be administered**

Math - In June we will be sending the math placement exam electronically. All incoming freshmen with the exception of Academic scholarship and grant recipients are required to take this exam. This exam will allow us to properly place students in the appropriate math class for freshmen year.

Spanish - Students who have selected Spanish as their first choice language to study AND have indicated they already speak Spanish or have studied it for more than a year will be required to take this exam. This exam will have a written (electronic) component and a speaking component (phone conversation with the Spanish teacher).
- **June 5, 2021 – First Tuition payment due.**

Please note that if you are making your payments in 10 monthly installments, this June payment will also include the one-time \$50 FACTS fee.
- **Wednesday, September 8, 2021 – Welcome Freshmen Day & Parent Meeting**

Welcome Freshmen Day
9AM – 12 PM (we ask student to please arrive no later than 8:50 AM).
On this day students will be asked to wear their Cathedral gym shirt. They may wear jeans or leggings and their sneakers. No shorts or ripped jeans will be allowed. Lunch will be provided to the students. A reminder email with more information will be sent over the summer.

Parent Meeting

A mandatory Parent Meeting will take place in our mini-theater.
- **Thursday, September 9, 2021 – First day of classes for the Class of 2025**

This will be the first day (full day) of classes for the Class of 2025. Students MUST wear their uniforms to school and report to Cathedral no later than 8AM. More information will be sent over the summer.



Cathedral High School Uniform Policy

Cathedral High School educates the whole person. A uniform/dress code is instituted for the following reasons:

- To help establish and maintain proper academic tone within the school community.

The school administration reserves the right to revise the dress code at any time it deems necessary. Additionally, the school administration reserves the right to make all final judgments in terms of the appropriateness of a student's attire and appearance.

The school uniform must be worn to and from school. Students must wear the uniform school slacks or skirt* along with the school shirt, blazer and mandated school shoes where applicable at all times. Any student out of dress code will be automatically suspended and be sent to in house suspension.

Mathematics:

All incoming freshmen are required to purchase either a **TI-83, TI-84 or TI 84 Plus Graphing Calculator.**

Science:

All incoming freshmen are required to purchase a **Texas Instrument TI-30 IIS or TI-30Xa Scientific Calculator.**

Summer Assignments:

All summer assignments (summer reading and math) will be posted on our website at the end of the school year in June. An email reminder will go out to all the parents.

Please know that over the summer, the itinerary for the first few days of school will be mailed out.
