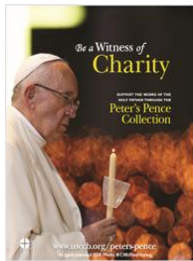
2019 MISSION APPEAL

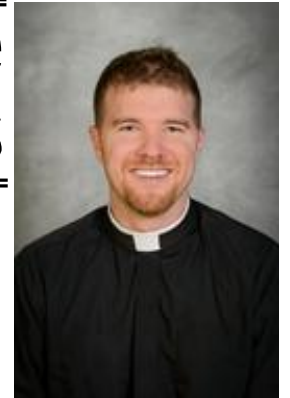
