Greetings to all!

Last week Fr. Stiles and I were away for the Companions of Christ yearly summer conference at Broomtree Retreat Center in Irene, SD. Since this group is an important part of our lives, I thought it might be worthwhile to explain a little bit about it this week in the bulletin.

The Companions of Christ a group that is perhaps best described as "Diocesan priests living in fraternity." We are "diocesan" in the sense that we are all priests of the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. This means that, unlike a members of a religious order who would report to the superior of the order, we still report to Archbishop Hebda. However, we "live in fraternity" in the sense that we make a commitment to gather together on a regular basis for prayer, meals, and sharing, and whenever possible, we live together in community.

We get our name from the New Jerusalem Bible translation of Mark 3:13-14, which says, "[Jesus] went up onto the mountain...and he appointed twelve; they were to be his companions and to be sent out to proclaim the message." One thing we find significant about this passage is that it describes Jesus calling the apostles first to be "his companions" (i.e. to live in relationship with him) and only second to be "sent out." This is important because it reminds us that our identity is not first and foremost found in what we do (i.e. our ministry), but in our relationship with Jesus. It is then only out of this relationship that our ministry flows forth.

When Jesus called his apostles, he not only called them to live in relationship with him, but also to live in relationship with each other. We see this especially when he chose to send them out two-by-two. And so, as Companions we try to live out our priesthood in this way.

Practically speaking, one of the most important ways we do this is by living together with other Companions when possible. Fr. Tom Niehaus (who is serving in Montgomery, Kilkenny, and Shieldsville), Fr. Stiles, and I are blessed to have this opportunity to live under the same roof right now. Some other important aspects of our lives as Companions are:

- praying a "holy hour" (hour of prayer) together as a household most mornings,
- eating meals together about twice a week,
- gathering as a large group (all 31 members) once a month for supper and prayer,
- and meeting in small groups about twice a month for personal sharing.

While it certainly is an added commitment to do these things, it is our hope that in the end it will help us be holier, happier, and healthier priests.
