**M**y dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Happy Sunday, the best day of the week! I am taking a break from writing on the topic of prayer (see previous weeks' bulletins) in order to begin presenting to you a wonderful event that will be unfolding over the next couple of years here in this Archdiocese.

On the eve of Pentecost, June 8th of this year, Archbishop Hebda formally initiated the Archdiocesan Synod. The what? The fact that this Archdiocese has not conducted a Synod since 1939, I wouldn't be at all surprised if most (if not all) of you have no idea what this is. I certainly did not when I first heard the term.

In a nutshell, "the goal of the Archdiocesan Synod is to help Archbishop Hebda discern, through a consultative process, the pastoral priorities of our local Church today – and into the near future" (<https://www.archspm.org/synod/>). What is unique about this "consultative process" is that those providing the consultation to the Archbishop is virtually everyone in this Archdiocese. "Your participation, as the Catholic faithful, is key to a successful Synod. You are invited to participate by offering your prayers, pastoral concerns, and ideas for moving this Archdiocese forward" (ibid).

How are you going to be able to provide important and necessary consultation to our bishop regarding the pastoral priorities of our Archdiocese? I will be explaining either in further bulletins or in some other format some of the nitty-gritty of this; for now, let me simply provide you with an overview of the Diocesan Synod process (for more info on the following, see <http://thecatholicspirit.com/2021synod/>).

Right now, we are in the what can be called the "pre-Synod" process during which all members of the Church can provide input to the Archbishop regarding what ought to be the pastoral priorities of the diocese. This gathering of input from all (that includes you) will be realized through hosting around the diocese Prayer and Listening Sessions (for a full list of these sessions, see <http://thecatholicspirit.com/special-sections/archsynod/archdiocesan-synod-planned-for-2021/>). As your pastor, I am highly encouraging you to attend as many of these events as you can, even if it is only one. "The listening sessions will bring hope for everyone, because at that moment they're all dreaming about what the Church could be, this new way of being Church..." (<http://thecatholicspirit.com/special-sections/archsynod/synod-process-aims-to-be-collaborative-wide-reaching-and-led-by-holy-spirit/>). You, as the laity of the Church, have an indispensable wealth of experience and a unique set of knowledge from which this diocese needs to benefit. Of course, for all of us, this must not become about pushing our own agendas, but, rather, only by approaching this whole process with a humble and prayerful spirit can we be confident that the Will of the Lord will be accomplished.

The Prayer and Listening sessions at large will come to an end on May 31st, 2020, the Feast of Pentecost. The Archbishop, assisted by an executive committee, will assemble a list of pastoral topics based on all the information gathered throughout the Prayer and Listening Sessions upon which parishes will be invited to form small groups under the direction of their pastors in order to discuss and pray together about these topics. I am hoping to have many small groups at our parishes in order to have as much substantive and prayerful thought about these issues as possible.

Following the parish-wide reflection and discussion on such topics over a course of several months, parishes will appoint delegates to meet with others on a regional level in order to continue to discuss, reflect, pray, and discern how God wants us to respond to the various pastoral issues. This, too, will take its course over several months.

Finally, on the Feast of Pentecost 2021, a number of delegates from across the diocese will be invited to attend actual Synod Assembly at which they will be invited to make recommendations to the Archbishop regarding the various pastoral topics that now have been "chewed on" and prayed with throughout the entire diocese.

After the Synod Assembly, the Archbishop will take time to prayerfully consider how to respond to the wisdom of the Holy Spirit gathered in and through the whole process and will ultimately craft a 5-10-year pastoral plan for our diocese. He hopes to have this written by November, 21st, 2021, the Feast of Christ the King. Then, of course, begins the hard part... implementation.

Again, brothers and sisters, this is meant to be a rough overview for you of what the Diocesan Synod is, how it will function, and its purpose. As a fellow member of the Holy Family we call the Church, I earnestly exhort you to be generous and to participate in whatever way you can in this Synod. Stay tuned for more information on how to do so... God bless!
