"I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly..." (JN 10:10)

"It was unpredictable. Who would have thought that the water could have risen that fast ...it was just so strong?" When Daniel O'Keefe tried to drive his vehicle through what had become fully submerged by flood-water due to a heavy flashflood, he was quickly trapped as his vehicle lost its grip and was pinned up against the base of a highway overpass. The water surged and threatened to soon engulf his vehicle and take his very life.

"Without him, I wouldn't be alive... I am so grateful." These were the emotional words of Daniel as he told reporters how a bystander had jumped into the raging, flood waters in order to help rescue him from his vehicle. "He risked his life for me! I don't even know him!"

The fictional story that you just read is not too far-fetched because we read about such stories from time-to-time in the newspaper or watch them on our favorite news channels. Such heroic and selfless acts inspire us and give us a sense of how truly selfless and brave we humans can be, especially when it comes to saving other human lives.

Shocking it is, then, to consider the number of acts committed every day that threaten or destroy human life, be they acts of abortion, euthanasia, war crimes, flagrant economic injustices fueled by greed, careless dismissal of immigrants, utter disrespect for our ecosystem...

Perhaps, you are already aware that the United State Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB) has declared October as Respect Life Month. The word respect literally means to "look again." During this month, we have the opportunity and, indeed, need to reassess and reaffirm the dignity of every human life from conception to natural death.

The dignity of every human being is rooted in the truth that each person is created in the image and likeness of God. In other words, of all the creatures of this earth, humans alone are 'godly.' Moreover, we know as Christians that since the coming of Jesus Christ, the Divinity of Christ has in some way touched all humanity. For this reason, C.S. Lewis once wrote that the holiest thing next to the tabernacle is the person standing next to you.

Friends, let's take some time this month to pray about how we might in some way better show proper respect for the dignity of all human beings, beginning of course with those closest to us. For the ways through which you are expressing your care for human life, thank you! Finally, let's remember that God is a lover of life. If indeed we are 'godly,' we must be lovers of life as well. God bless you!
