A Fresh look...

A Blessed Sunday to you! It has been a while since I've written to you regarding an important event that is taking place in this Archdiocese and that will directly involve our parish over the course of the next year and a half. This important event is the Archdiocesan Synod, and it involves and will affect all of us.

In a nutshell, "the goal of the Archdiocesan Synod is to help [our bishop,] Archbishop Hebda, discern, through a consultative process, the pastoral priorities of our local Church today – and into the near future" (<https://www.archspm.org/synod/>). What is unique about this "consultative process" is that those providing the consultation to the Archbishop is virtually everyone in this Archdiocese.

Perhaps you are unaware of it, but the Archbishop is asking you to provide him with key information so that he can better understand what's working well in this Archdiocese and in our parishes and how we need to improve. If you could answer these two questions, "What's working well in your parish and the Archdiocese and what could be improved," what would you say? How many times in your *life has the bishop asked you for your opinion on how we can grow and improve as Church?!?* This is truly a unique opportunity.

There are several ways in which you can help provide the Archbishop with the information he is asking of you, but for now I want to focus on the most immediate way you can do so. The Archbishop is hosting "prayer and listening sessions" around the Archdiocese. At these events, people from across the Archdiocese pray together and seek to answer the two questions mentioned above. The results of the attendees' prayer and reflection is then communicated to the Archbishop there in person. In the process, the attendees can learn a great deal from each other of the various needs and common desires of the people of God of this diocese. I emphatically encourage you to attend one of the remaining prayer and listening sessions so that the Archbishop can receive as much Spirit-guided input as is possible (see bulletin insert for a full list of dates and locations as well as more general info on what the synod is).
