You are all invited and welcome to attend the 34th Annual Catholic Mutual General Insurance Seminar. (You are not required to attend, but you are invited to attend if you wish and you are able.)

June 8th, 9th & 11th, 2021 will be the 2021 Catholic Mutual Group's 34th Annual General Insurance Seminar and "Prize Extravaganza" via WebEx & Zoom. The Gift of gifts

My dear friends in Christ,

I have been so blessed to grow up with loving parents. Like all children, I certainly didn't always agree with my parents. There were plenty of times that I believed that I knew better than they did on some matter of disagreement. Nevertheless, I always knew that my parents loved me. This was and remains an immense gift to me.

Perhaps the greatest way they expressed their love for me was by sharing with me and helping to cultivate within me the gift of faith. My parents chose to introduce me to the Lord by baptizing me, through daily prayers said together, frequent faith-based conversations around the dinner table, worshipping our God every Sunday together at Mass, reading bible stories together, teaching me how to apply the teachings of the Faith in everyday circumstances, still engaging me in conversations of faith to this day, and so much more...

I have been doing a fair amount of thinking recently about the importance of sharing the faith. It cannot be overstated: the greatest gift we can give to our children is the gift of faith! Every other gift of this world will pass away, but the gift of faith leads a child toward eternal happiness with God.

To all parents reading this who still have relatively young children, I encourage you to share with your children to the best of your ability this most precious of gifts. Do not be afraid! You may think, "I don't know the faith well myself...How can I share it well with my children?"; or, "I know faith is important, but there are so many other things in my child's life that demand their attention. It's just too hard to make faith the priority."; or, "Wouldn't it just be better for me to let them make their own decisions about faith once they're an adult?"

To those parents who don't know the Catholic faith well. It's never too late to learn more about why we Catholics believe what we do, and, thankfully, there are no shortage of resources. Remember, out of great love for you, the Lord wants you to know as much as you can about Him so that your affection and love will naturally grow for Him. As your knowledge and love of God grows, your desire and capacity to share Him with your children (not to mention everyone else) will grow.

To those parents who are battling the busyness of life and raising children in the faith in our day, have courage! It's ok to say no. It's ok, in fact it's good, to prioritize your child's faith above all things. Your children don't need to be involved in everything if that means it's going in some way to harm their faith life. God promises you His help in making wise decisions for the good of your children's faith (for the good of their immortal soul!).

To parents who believe it might be better to simply allow their children to discover and choose their own faith path once they've reached adulthood, please, hear me. You are not robbing your child's freedom by sharing with them the gift of the Catholic faith and cultivating that within them at a young age. On the contrary, you do the opposite! This is because it is our gift of faith which ultimately makes us truly free. Leading a life of faith frees us from enslavement to sin and thereby gives us the desire and ability to act and think in ways in accord with the truth. This is true human freedom!

Finally, to more aged parents who have raised your children in the Catholic faith, doing the best you knew how at the time, but whose children have left the Catholic faith, don't be discouraged. Continue to pray for them. As much as you love them and want to see them in heaven someday, God wants it even more. Remember this. Never lose hope in the Lord's ability to bring your children back to faith. Listen to the simple but profound words of St. Padre Pio, "Pray, hope, and don't worry!"

Yes, the sharing and cultivation of the gift of faith rightly begins in the family. Let us all also remember our common responsibility as a community of faith to help inspire faith in our children and young people and even in one another.
