Ideally, you would attend all six sessions, but it is not necessary. Even just attending one would be beneficial for you and our parishes.

Where? Nativity Social Hall

What? **1. Pray**—Each evening will begin with prayer. We will specifically learn how to pray using Holy Scripture.

2. Learn—In a pre-recorded video presentation, the bishops (and perhaps others) will help us better understand the relevant Catholic truths of our faith which pertain to our 3 focus areas of discussion outlined in last weekend's bulletin article.

3. Listen—We are going to listen to what the Lord is stirring in our own hearts and minds as we learn better our faith and engage in discussion. We will listen to each other express our viewpoints in a spirit of charity. We

4. Discuss—After having been given some solid teaching from our bishops (and possibly others), we will have time in our small groups to freely discuss the topic of the evening presented to us. The small groups will be made up of roughly 5-8 people.

How? The evenings will be almost wholly guided by a video presentation with step-by-step instructions. There will also be volunteers on-site to make sure everything runs smoothly and well.

We are inviting all high school-aged and above to participate in these parish small groups! Please, mark your calendars!
