Temperature Screenings

- Temperature readings will be required daily for students, teachers, and staff.

Cleaning and Disinfecting

- Mask-wearing policy will adhere to CDC, state, and local guidelines.
- Classroom setups will honor social distancing.

Visitor and Volunteer Policy

- Visitors and volunteers will be limited in order to keep germs from spreading.

Large Events

- Masses, sporting events and school events will adhere to social distancing rules.

In-person and Virtual Learning

- Classes are expected to begin in-person, with virtual options for students and parents who prefer them.
