Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven,
whose sin is covered.

Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity,
and in whose spirit there is no deceit. Psalm 32:1-2

The Psalmist captures for us the true sense of Lent and Easter. Through the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, our sins are forgiven and we gain eternal life. All that was lost at the Garden of Eden is restored. The effects of sin still remain but the sentence for our sins has been taken on by the Lamb of God. It is critical to a clear understanding of the Triduum and of Easter to see it through the prism of the Passover. What happens follows exactly what we see in Exodus 12. But many do not understand this. Study the Passover and then study the Passion. Open up the intricacies of the parallel. That will help you to enter more fully into the Triduum.
