If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind. James 1:5–6

There are two things to notice about this passage. The first is that James is saying that we should ask for wisdom, not knowledge. Wisdom will guide us through things in which knowledge could flounder. It is wisdom that we must seek and not knowledge. The second thing is that we need to ask in faith. We are all guilty of going to God like He is a genie or a wishing well. When we do not get what we want, we may become disappointed. Go to God in faith and ask in faith. You may not get exactly what you asked for but you will get what you need.
