"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13:34–35

This command appears in a few places in John's Last Supper Discourses. The qualifier here is what makes it meaningful. Jesus tells His disciples – and, by extension, us- to love as He has loved us. Well, on Thursday night, that means one thing. On Friday afternoon, it takes on a deeper meaning. It means a self-emptying love that can have no limits. It means a life literally poured out in service to others. Do you have that love? Are you willing to live it out?
