Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation—if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good. 1 Peter 2:2–3

The verse before this says to rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, insincerity, envy and all slander. That tends to put a different light on the passage that follows. It is not just that we should seek what is pure but that there are things specifically we should avoid. If we can draw away from the bad things listed, we have a better chance of seeking the good things. This section of this epistle quotes Scripture extensively. It begins with the author quoting Psalm 34 – Taste and see that the Lord is good.
