

# St. Paul Chapter National Junior Honor Society Membership Expectations

1. All members are to maintain the standards by which they were selected:
  - 93% cumulative average with no rounding in all academic subject areas
  - Conduct grade of A in all specials classes
  - Conduct and effort grade of A in all academic subjects, including Religion
  - Outstanding character, leadership, service, and citizenship
  - Outstanding record of conduct and behavior with regard to school and community rules, guidelines, and policies.
2. Attendance: Members are expected to attend monthly chapter meetings. All members are responsible for knowing what happens at monthly chapter meetings.
3. Members are encouraged to attend leadership trainings such as MAHS conventions and conferences.
4. Service: Service is defined as any activity whose impact is felt within the community. Members are required to participate in chapter service activities. Members are required to complete a minimum of twenty total hours of service yearly. Hours accumulated during chapter service projects and individual service projects are included in the twenty hour total. Confirmation candidates may count five hours of Confirmation service toward this requirement.

The national constitution mandates that each chapter conduct a chapter service project each year and suggests that chapters choose one or more additional major projects for the school year. Each member is expected to participate in the planning and execution of these projects.

Additionally, all members of NJHS are expected to select individual service projects based on the member's particular talents and interests.
