When will we know the schedule for the rest of the year?

- As indicated in last week's communication: The end of the Distance Learning School Year will be May 29th.

Are you still accepting Scholarship Applications?

- Yes, we are still accepting applications for the Educational Trust Scholarships, St. Paul Scholarships and the AOD Scholarships. **The deadline for all Scholarships has been extended to May 15th.**

Do I still pay my tuition for the 2020/2021 School Year?

Do we still receive the 3% Discount on the tuition if it is paid in full by May 1st or has that been extended?

- We have extended the deadline to register and pay in full to receive the 3% discount to June 1st.

- The Sacraments of Communion and Confirmation have been postponed, we will keep you updated on the new dates as those become available.
- Our handling of graduation, and the related activities, are still being considered, and more information will be provide in the future.
