Student Scholarship Guidelines

2021-2022

The Columbiettes of St. Ignatius Loyola #12853 offers an annual scholarship for an outstanding high school senior who is active in Holy Family Parish and plans to attend a college, university or accredited career school in upcoming Fall Semester.

1. Qualifications
 - a. Be an active member of Holy Family Parish, for example, Mass attendance, Life Teen, Teen Retreat Vacation Bible Camp, altar server, Eucharistic Minister, etc.
 - b. Have a preferred minimum GPA of 3.0 (PE excluded).
 - c. Submit a typed essay (minimum of 100 words) describing what your faith means to you or who/ what was important in your faith formation.
 - d. Name any awards received, club membership, or sports activities.
 - e. Name any of your volunteer services with the number of hours served.
 - f. Submit two letters of recommendation using choices below:
 - Active Holy Family Parishioner (excluding family member).
 - Teacher/Counselor
 - Service Organization Member
2. Complete the application with the attached information above and place in a sealed envelope marked **Columbiette Scholarship** in the Columbiette Box in the Holy Family Parish Office by 1:00 pm on **February 27, 2022**.
3. You will receive a written notification of your scholarship status at the completion of the selection process.
4. If chosen to receive the scholarship, send to the Columbiette Chairperson, proof of registration and payment for associated expenses (books, etc.). Once this is received, the scholarship money will be mailed to you.
5. The scholarship funds may be canceled if proof of registration and payment of associated expenses are not met by **October 14, 2022**.
