

Holy Family Festival COVID Safety Protocols

- We are following (at a minimum) all CDC and Santa Clara County Guidelines in regard to COVID Safety
- Carnival operators will be wearing masks and are vaccinated
- **Masks are required** to be worn by all Volunteers and Attendees of the Festival, regardless of vaccination status
 - Exceptions are Children under the age of 2
 - Masks may be removed while eating or drinking in while seated or gathered in a small group away from Walkways or Food & Game booths
 - Masks **May Not** be removed when indoors (Silent Auction, Bookworm, Restrooms, Festival Office, Hospitality Room)
- We are running at 50% Capacity for Food & Game booths to ensure distancing between booths
- We encourage volunteers working in booths to maintain Social Distancing to the greatest extent possible while working the booth
- We will have the normal number of tables, but will space out as much as possible
- Hand Sanitizer and Disinfectant Spray will be available in multiple locations throughout the Festival
 - We encourage attendees to wipe down table and chairs before use
- Food Booths will clean all surfaces at regular intervals as directed by the Health Department
