Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

In today's Gospel, Mary's visit to her cousin Elizabeth, tells us that Mary, a woman alone and waiting for her baby, made a journey more than fifty miles from Galilee to Ain Karin in the mountainous area of Judah. Today there is a Catholic church on that site. Her many paintings depict Elizabeth and Mary, and other women of their time, performing the sacred task of keeping their religious traditions alive. I don't think there's another church like that around the world.

When Mary, now the Ark of the Covenant, the bearer of the Savior, arrives at her cousin's house, she sings the Magnificat. This tells us of that which seems to occupy her mind more than anything. And, curiously, it is not the new ones of her surprising pregnancy, or the pregnancy of her elderly cousin. Instead, she wants to talk about God's power to lift up the humble and fill the poor with good things.

It makes you wonder what Mary might have seen on that path which she traveled. The widows or orphans crying for something to eat, rejected, and removed from the safety nets of their husbands and fathers? Did she see Jews executed, crucified by the Romans on the side of these roads so trafficked as reminders of "Roman Dominion"? When she arrived at her cousin's house, John in his womb felt the presence of the one true Prince of Peace. That six-month-old fetus was the first to recognize the Incarnation, traveling in the womb of its mother Mary. That should fulminate any doubt about when life begins.

As that charming hymn of the Medical Missionaries, The Visitation, says, *"there jumped a child in the old womb. And there was a little hope in every ancient tomb."* So beautiful.

What do you think young Maria was thinking as she traveled to see her cousin?

El Evangelio de hoy, la visita de María a su prima Isabel, nos cuenta que María, una mujer sola y esperando bebé, hizo un viaje de más de cincuenta millas desde Galilea hasta Ain Karin, en el área montañosa de Judá. Hoy en día hay una iglesia católica en ese sitio. Sus muchas pinturas representan a Isabel y María, y a otras mujeres de su época, realizando la sagrada tarea de mantener vivas sus tradiciones religiosas. No creo que exista otra iglesia como esa en todo el mundo.

Cuando María, ahora el Arca de la Alianza, la portadora del Salvador, llega a la casa de su prima, ella canta el Magnificat. Esto nos indica que lo que parece ocupar su mente más que nada, curiosamente, no son las nuevas de su sorprendente embarazo, ni siquiera el embarazo de su anciana prima. En lugar de eso, ella quiere hablar del poder de Dios para levantar a los humildes y llenar a los pobres de cosas buenas.

Te hace preguntarte que vería en ese camino en el que viajó. ¿Vio acaso viudas o huérfanos llorando por algo de comer, rechazados y alejados de las redes de seguridad de sus esposos y padres? ¿Vio acaso judíos ejecutados, crucificados por los romanos a lado de estos caminos tan traficados como recordatorios del "Dominio Romano"? Cuando llegó a casa de su prima, Juan en el vientre sintió la presencia del único y verdadero Príncipe de la Paz. Ese feto de seis meses fue el primero en reconocer la Encarnación, viajando en el vientre de su madre María. Eso debe fulminar cualquier duda acerca de cuando comienza la vida.

Tal como dice ese encantador himno de los Misioneros Médicos, La Visita, *Allí saltó un niño en el vientre antiguo. Y había un poco de esperanza en cada tumba antigua.* Tan hermoso.
