Welcome to 6th Grade!

The following is the revised list of supplies you will need for both your classroom work as well as for Fine Arts. Please keep in mind that no supplies can be shared between students. Make sure your name is on **everything**. See you in September!!!

- 1 12 inch wooden ruler (not metal or flexible)
  - 6 sharpened #2 pencils (not mechanical)
  - 1 of each of the following pens: black, blue, red and green
  - 6 large marble copybooks \*\* binders or spiral notebooks are **not** permitted
  - 8 2-pocket folders
  - 1 pack of theme paper
  - 2 soft pencil cases (you could also use large ziplock 1 or 2 gallon bags)
  - 1 case (or ziplock bag) for pencils and the 2nd case (or ziplock bag) is for art supplies
  - 1 plastic shoe box (available at the dollar store)
  - 1 24 pack of crayons
  - 1 12 pack (or more) of colored pencils
  - 1 12 pack (or more) of thick or thin markers (water based, not permanent)
  - 1 watercolor paint set with a paint brush (8 or more colors)
  - 1 white Pentel Hi-polymer eraser
  - 1 yellow highlighter
  - Scissors
  - Scotch tape
  - 2 glue sticks
  - 1 pack of 3x5 index cards
  - 1 Individual pack of tissues (or put an individual supply in a ziplock sandwich bag for you to use; students cannot share from a central box in the classroom)
  - 2 jumbo book socks
  - 1 cloth placemat (or dish towel)
  - 1 small individual bottle of hand sanitizer
  - 1 container of Lysol or Clorax wipes
- Students will not be able to use the water fountains in the hallways. They may bring in a water bottle from home. A sport's pop top is preferred to a twist off top (trying to avoid spillage.)
