2020-2021 Parking Policy Effective: August 1, 2020

1. Introduction

- Any motor vehicle parked on St. Thomas Aquinas University Parish (STAUP) that is in violation of Arkansas motor vehicle statutes or STAUP regulations is subject to being towed.
- All STAUP parking permits must be clearly displayed.
- Permits are only valid for 1 vehicle to whom they are registered. (unless other arrangements have been agreed upon)
- STAUP parking permits are required for parking in the STAUP parking lot during the listed times. If not displayed, vehicle is subject to 1 warning then will be towed and permit will be voided with no refund.
 - Monday-Friday 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - Saturdays when classes or final examinations are scheduled.
 - Requests for extended parking time(s) will be settled on a case-by-case basis and may be subject to an additional cost.
- The responsibility for locating a legal parking space rests with the motor vehicle operator.
- STAUP assumes no responsibility for loss of or damage to private property. Therefore, all unattended vehicles parked at STAUP should be locked.

2. Renewing parking permits

- A \$50.00 non-refundable deposit is required with all application renewals and is due at time of renewal application. (this deposit is applied to permit fee) .
- **Changes to renewals**
 - Each student parishioner will need to have the last page of the application signed off by Adam Koehler or Juliane Pierini. (we also accept letter of good standing from your home parish if you're unable to catch our Campus Ministers)

3. Parking permit waiting list

- Please note: There is a 2 year wait list currently.

4. Parking Permit Cost break down

- **STAUP parishioners - \$250.00**
 - 20 spaces available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Must be student, faculty or staff of the University of Arkansas.
 - *Must be contributing (financially and/or through Catholic Campus Ministry) registered Parishioner at St. Thomas*
 - Vehicle must be removed from the lot by midnight on the eve of a home game.
- **Non-STAUP parishioners - \$350.00**
 - 20 spaces available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - non-St Thomas Aquinas University Parishioners.
 - Vehicle must be removed from the lot by midnight on the eve of a home game.

5. Event Parking

- **Razorback home game parking - \$20.00 per car**
 - Spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - No advanced reservation is available
 - Permit holders must vacate lot by midnight prior to home games
 - i) And are subject to pay game day parking fee
- **St. Thomas Church Event & Visitor Parking**
 - Visitors may park in the STAUP parking lot to attend church events, church meetings and church appointments.
 - **Visitors must check in at church office and place a temporary parking permit in your car to ensure it is not towed while on church business.**
 - Church event parking (apart from Razorback game day) is on a first come, first served basis.
- **Special Events (Funerals, Weddings, etc.) and Parking Lot Maintenance**
 - When necessary, St. Thomas will send an e-mail notification to permit holders 48 hours prior to event (funerals will be 24-hour notice) that the parking lot will be closed off for a special event (funeral, wedding, etc.)
 - Parking lot maintenance is done during June & July of each summer. Permit holders will receive email notification within 72 hours, if parking lot is not available.

6. Motor Vehicle Owner Notices

- STAUP reserves the right to tow from its property any parked vehicle without a current parking permit.
- It is the responsibility of any motorist whose vehicle becomes inoperative in the STAUP parking lot to immediately notify the office of the vehicle's status and have vehicle removed within 24 hours.
- Vehicles are considered abandoned when parked and stationary for 72 hours. (*without prior approval from Parish office*) Abandoned vehicles will be towed from the parking lot and custody of the vehicle will rest with the tow company.
- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to notify STAUP of any change in address or phone number(s).
- **Unauthorized transfer of parking permits will result in parking privileges being denied or revoked and fees paid forfeited.**
- Enforcement of these parking regulations is the responsibility of STAUP.
