

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Total Tour Price: The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect May 22, 2020. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. Refunds CANNOT be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 35 pilgrims participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

Passport And Visa Requirements: A valid passport is required. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Passport MUST be valid until January 15, 2022 or later. Citizens of countries other than U.S. – please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

Air Transportation: International flight reservations are being held on American Airlines. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON-TRANSFERABLE AND NON-REFUNDABLE. Any requests to change a ticket once issued will incur a reissue fee of \$200 plus any fare differential will apply. Cancellation of air seat within 90 days of departure will incur a \$200 penalty.

Domestic Airfare: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

Hotel Accommodations: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$595 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

Meals: Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

Tips And Taxes: Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, portage of one suitcase per person. International departure taxes of \$101 plus current fuel surcharges of \$438 are included (subject to change). TIPS TO TOUR MANAGER/GUIDES, DRIVERS OR DINING ROOMS STAFF OF \$99 ARE NOT INCLUDED. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth) is permitted throughout the trip.

Not Included: Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, tips and taxes mentioned above, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

Deposits And Cancellations: A deposit of \$500 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received at Unitours after 45 days before departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. (This does not apply for new reservations made after 45 days of departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Discover, Visa and MasterCard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date including insurance. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure – \$100 processing charge plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 31 days of departure – \$150 processing charge plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. There can be no refund for any services for cancellations received within 30 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

Bank Fee: A fee of \$50 will be charged for any check that is returned to us for insufficient or unavailable funds.

Deviations: A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.

Travel Insurance: Optional Travel Insurance is strongly recommended for your trip. See www.Unitours.com/TravelInsurance for full details including optional Cancel for any reason coverage. (NOT AVAILABLE FOR NEW YORK RESIDENTS.) Cost of travel insurance for this trip starts at \$237. To cover preexisting conditions, insurance must be purchased with your reservation. (See reservation form). If paying by check, add insurance cost to your deposit. Insurance can also be purchased at the time of your final payment.

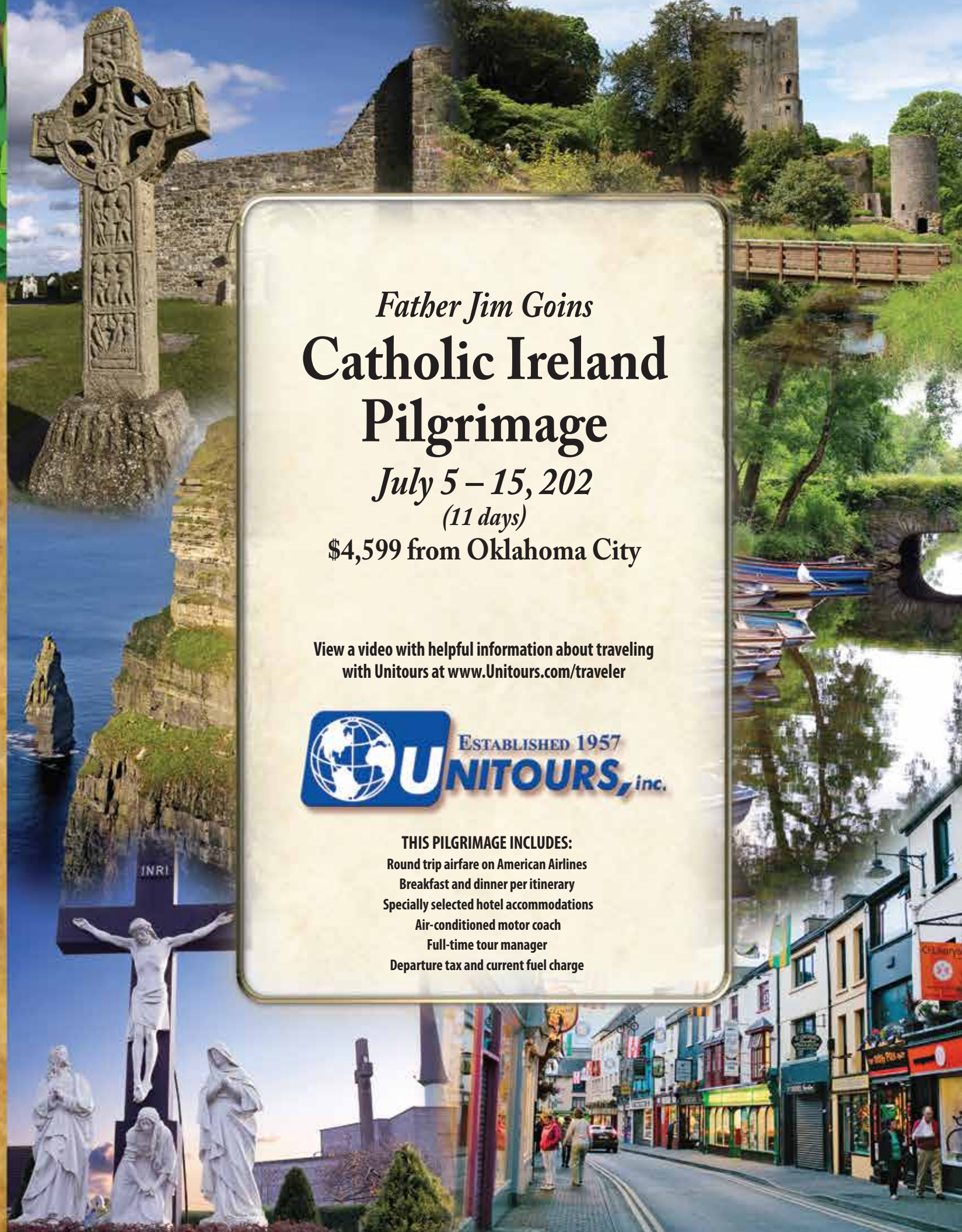

ITINERARY

Monday, July 5 – Day 1 – Depart USA – We depart Oklahoma City to connect with our overnight flight to Dublin, with complimentary meals served aloft.

Tuesday, July 6 – DAY 2 – DUBLIN /WATERFORD – Arrive Dublin Airport and to the Viking city of Waterford. En-route journey through the colorful Wicklow Mountains and visit Glendalough where there is a beautiful lake and extensive century monastic ruins which set up by St Kevin in the 6th century. We conclude our visit nearby at the Church of St. Kevin for Mass. Also stop at Avoca Handweavers, the oldest working mill in Ireland, for a weaving demonstration and spot of shopping. Dinner and overnight Waterford.

Wednesday, July 7 – Day 3 – WATERFORD – Enjoy the day exploring Ireland's South East. In the rolling countryside of County Kilkenny, you'll experience a heritage tour, sheepdog demo and tea and scones at Jerpoint Park. On this picturesque farm lies the ruins of the abandoned medieval town of Newtown Jerpoint as well as the remains of St Nicholas of Myra. Conditions permitting, we will celebrate our outdoor Mass here. Return to Waterford for a glass making demonstration at the famous House of Waterford Crystal and free time in the city. Dinner and overnight Waterford.

Thursday, July 8 – DAY 4 – TRALEE – This morning we depart Waterford and journey to Tralee in County Kerry. En-route visit Blarney Castle and perhaps ascend the steps of the main town to kiss the Blarney Stone to gain the 'gift of the gab'. Afterwards enjoy time for shopping at Blarney Woolen Mills before we celebrate Mass at Church of the Immaculate Conception here in Blarney. We continue to County Kerry with dinner and overnight Tralee.

Friday, July 9 – DAY 5 – RING OF KERRY – This morning, we experience the exhilarating 111-mile Ring of Kerry loop. One of the world's most famous drives gives plenty of opportunities for photo stops, such as Ladies View and Moll's Gap. On the way back to Tralee enjoy a jaunting car (horse and cart) ride through the tranquil Killarney National Park. We conclude with Mass at St Mary's Cathedral in Killarney. Return to Tralee for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Saturday, July 10 – DAY 6 – GALWAY – Today we depart Tralee and journey to Galway. En-route journey along the Dingle Peninsula, which is less famous but just as beautiful, as the Ring of Kerry. Along this coastal route are a number of ancient Christian structures, including the upside-down boat shaped Gallarus Oratory which we visit. We celebrate Mass along our route at St Mary's Church in Dingle. Continue direct to the atmospheric city of Galway for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Sunday, July 11 – St. Benedict – DAY 7 – GALWAY – Today we explore the Burren Region. This unusual landscape of moon-like limestone plateau where you can find the huge 702 ft high Cliffs of Moher. We begin with Mass at Saint John the Baptist Parish in Ballyvaughan. We continue to visit the 13th century Ennis Friary which is home to a Franciscan order and ornate statues. Return to Galway for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Monday, July 12 – DAY 8 – CONNEMARA/KNOCK/SLIGO – This morning we continue up the dramatic Wild Atlantic Way from Galway City to County Sligo. We journey past the lakes, bogs and marble mountains of the wild Connemara region, and stop to visit the beautifully located gothic styled Kylemore Abbey. We enjoy another short stop at base of Croagh Patrick (not possible to visit visitor center) where St Patrick fasted for 40 days at the summit. Finally, we visit and celebrate mass at Knock Shrine, the site of the Marian apparition to villagers in 1879. Dinner and overnight in Sligo.

Tuesday, July 13 – DAY 9 – DONEGAL – Today we journey a short way up the coast from County Sligo to County Donegal. En-route photo stop at Drumcliff Cemetery – in the shadow of the sugarloaf Benbulbin mountain – where Ireland's national poet WB Yeats is buried. We continue past rugged County Donegal to the highest sea cliffs in Europe at Slieve League. On the way back to Donegal, we celebrate Mass at St Mary of the Visitation in Killybegs. Continue to Donegal for dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Wednesday, July 14 – DAY 10 – DONEGAL/DUBLIN – This morning we depart on the cross-country drive to Dublin. On arrival we enjoy a panoramic tour including the impressive monuments of the north side of the River Liffey and the regal Georgian architecture of the south side. At the Trinity College we see the ornate Book of Kells from the 9th century and the 200,000 books of The Old Library. We conclude our day with Mass at St Mary's Pro Cathedral. This evening we enjoy a traditional Irish dinner and entertainment from some of Dublin's finest musicians and Irish dancers at The Merry Ploughboy Pub or similar. Overnight in Dublin.

Thursday, July 15 – DAY 11 – RETURN TO USA – This morning we transfer to Dublin airport for our return flight to the USA with fond memories of our Irish journey.
