Ongoing Formation Opportunity for Ministerial Personnel

St. Peter’s Seminary is offering “The Canon Law on Marriage,” a thirteen-week course that begins on Thursday, Jan. 10, 2019, and will be taught by Rev. Paul Baillargeon, Chancellor and Judicial Vicar of the Diocese of London. Each weekly class will be two hours in length, beginning at 9:30 a.m. The course will cover the current canonical legislation on marriage, including preparation for marriage, the impediments to marriage, the legislation on mixed marriage, the form of marriage, inter-ritual marriage, as well as the canonical processes to be followed in the dissolution of the bond and in declaring a marriage null. The course is designed to provide parish pastoral personnel with practical information and skills in the area of marriage. This course may be taken for credit or simply audited. The tuition for credit, including all university fees, is \$763.46; the tuition to audit is \$336.15.
