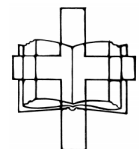

Keep Connected Parent/teen Workshop **St. Michael's Parish Hall- Leamington**

It's easy for families to get disconnected as kids grow and other demands pull families apart. The Keep Connected program provides an opportunity to draw families back together and give them skills to use over the coming years. This program is designed for parents and their 10-14 year old youth. The unique aspect about this program is that it is truly a "family centered" event as child care for younger children will also be provided. Each evening begins with a meal together. Following the meal parents and young people will be split into separate rooms to have their own sessions. Some of the discussion and activities focus on respecting each other, showing how we matter to each other, challenging us to grow, and more. The cost is **\$25 per family** to help cover the cost of the meals each evening. This six week program will be held on **Thursday's** beginning on **February 21**.

Centering Prayer Introductory Workshop

Centering Prayer is traditionally called Contemplative Prayer. Centering Prayer is both a prayer and a discipline which invites us to open our minds and hearts – our whole being – to God, the Ultimate Mystery, beyond thoughts, words and emotions. Centering Prayer facilitates the movement from more active modes of prayer – verbal, mental or affective prayer – into more receptive prayer of 'resting in God'.

This introductory workshop (Session 1) includes both instruction and group practice in the method of Centering Prayer.
